1. Introduction

The **PostFinance Checkout Flex extension** from PIT Solutions serves as a connector between PostFinance Checkout Flex and the Odoo Web Shop. It provides a standardized way to accept payments through a wide variety of payment providers worldwide. The extension supports payment gateways such as **PostFinancePay**, **TWINT**, **PayPal**, **Online Banking**, and **Credit/Debit Cards**. More information is available under **PostFinance Checkout Flex**.

This extension links Odoo Shop users to a payment hub, which has over 50 payment gateways and processors integrated. It operates using the **Rest API**, helping to reduce cart abandonment by offering customers their preferred payment gateway. It also integrates with different payment service provider APIs, lowering payment routing costs.

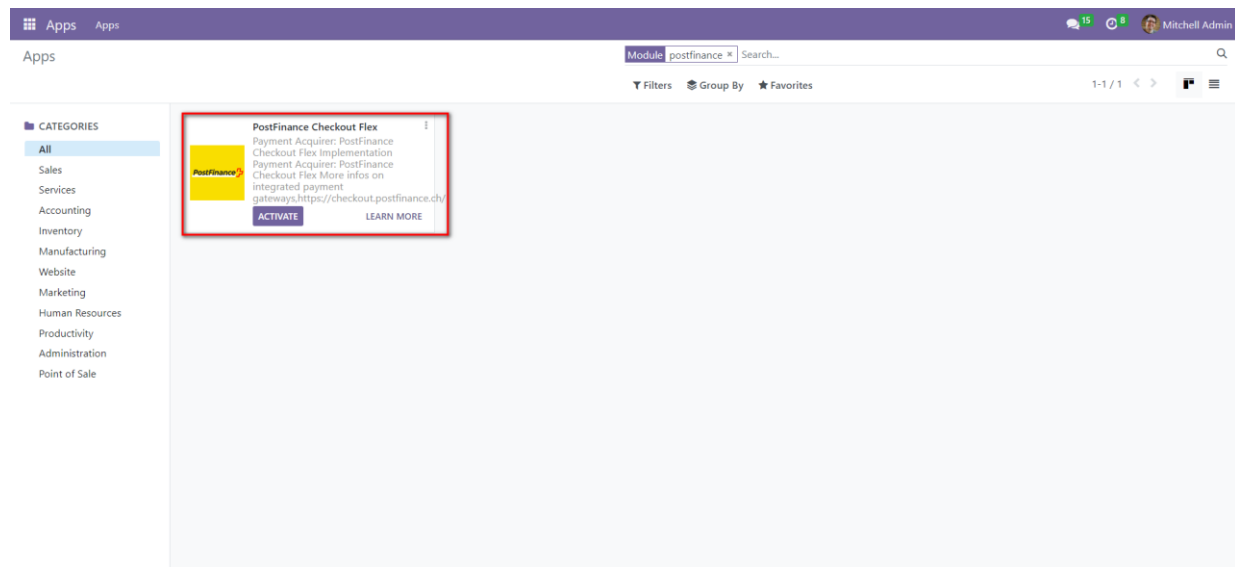
2. Features

- Easy to install.
- Flexible.
- User-friendly and configurable to meet specific requirements.

- Supports payment gateways like PostFinance Pay, TWINT, PayPal, Online Banking, and Credit/Debit Cards.
- Offers payment methods for processors such as **Worldline**, **TWINT**, **PostFinance Acquiring**, and **PayPal**.

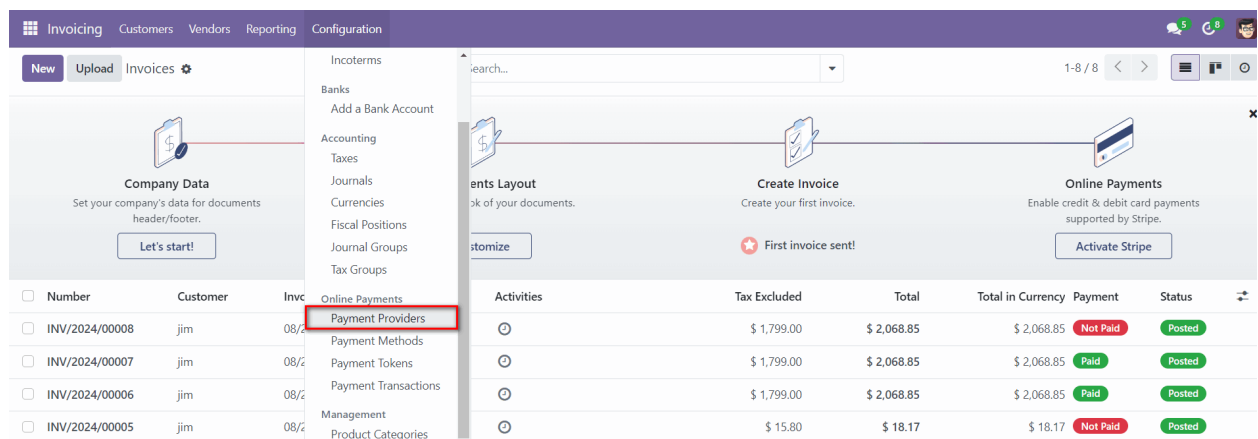
Install the PostFinance module:

- Click *Activate*.



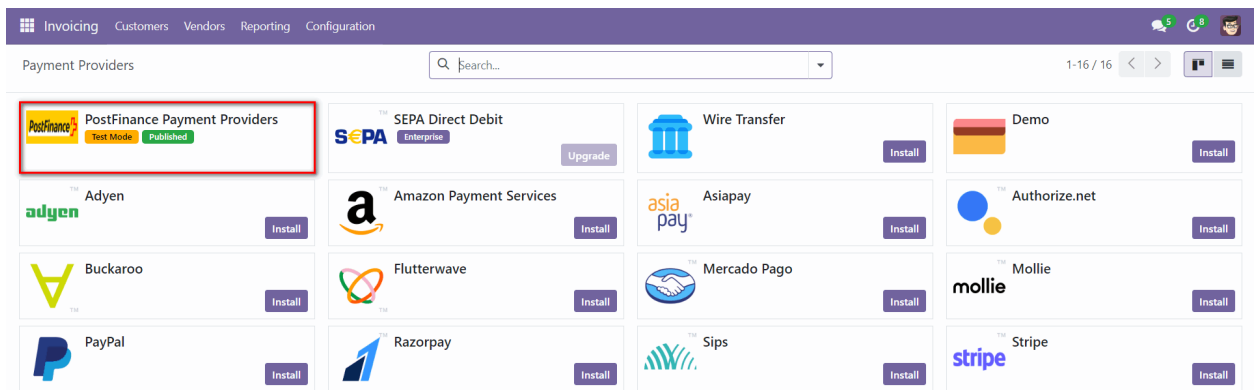
Screenshot 1: PostFinance app activation

- Go to *Invoicing* module -> *Configuration* -> Select *Payment Providers*.



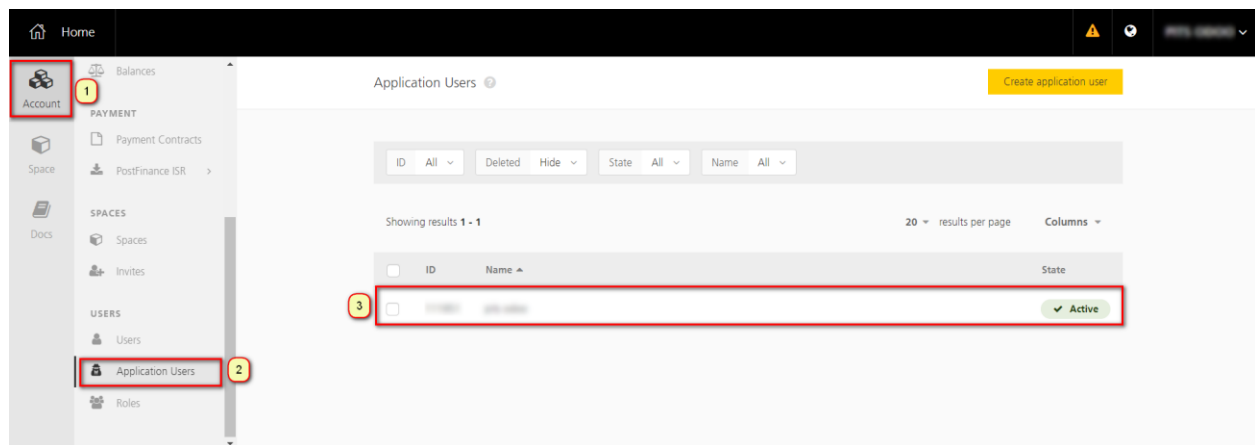
Screenshot 2: Payment Providers menu item

- Click on *PostFinance Payment Providers*.



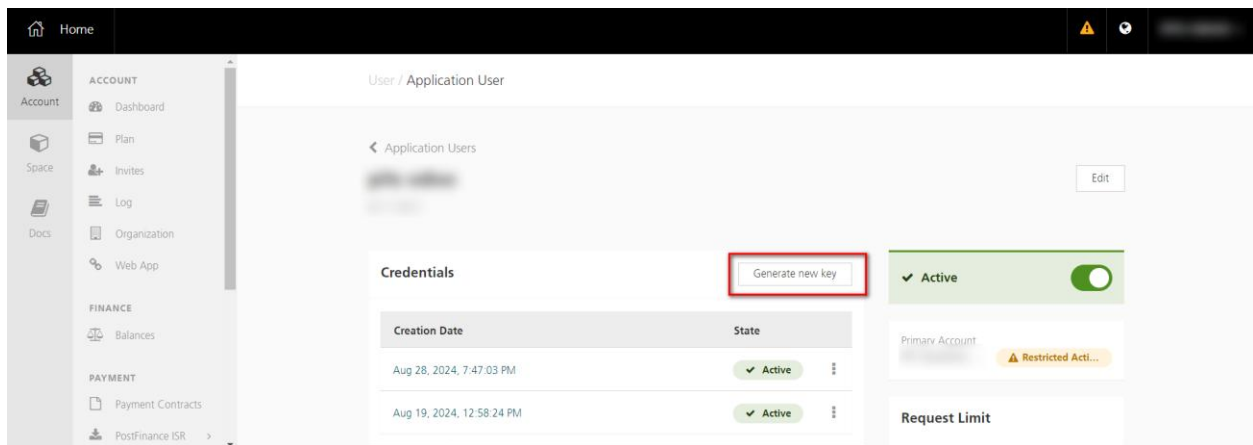
Screenshot 3: PostFinance Payment Provider

Screenshot 4: PostFinance Account Page

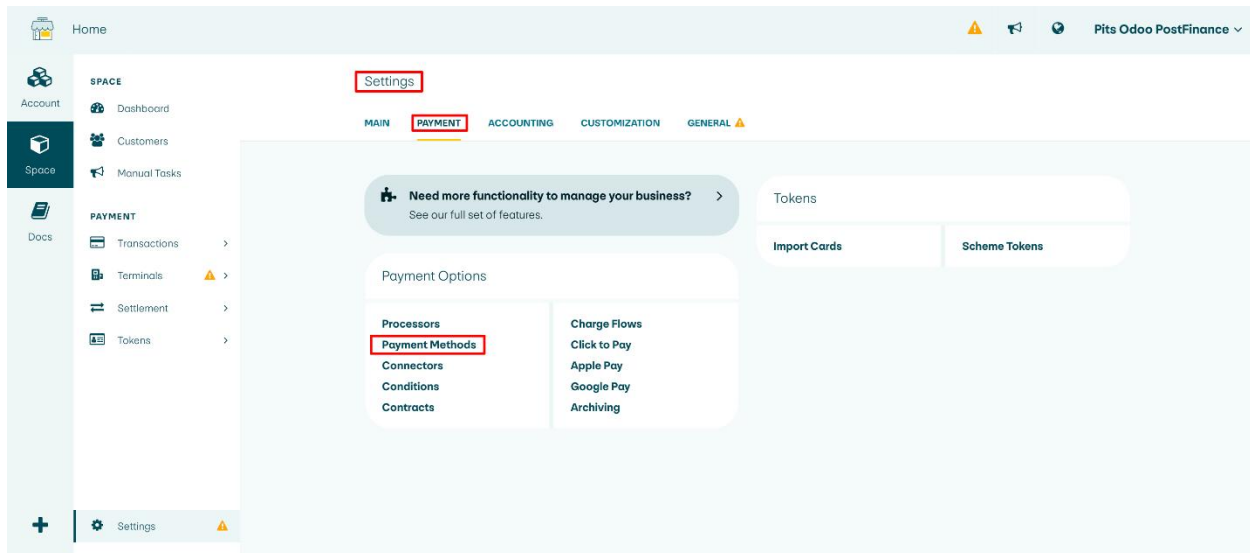
- Generate new key -> Copy the generated key.



Screenshot 5: PostFinance New key Generation

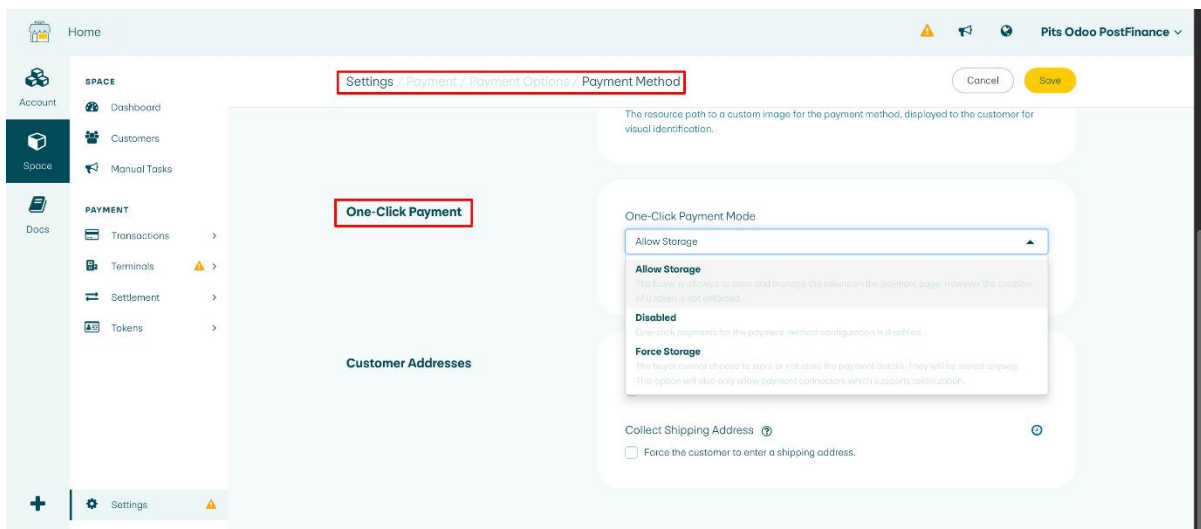
- Go to *Spaces*-> Fetch the *Space ID*.
- Enter the *Rest API UserID*, *Rest API Space ID* and *Application Key* to PostFinance payment provider configuration in Odoo backend.
- Move the payment provider to desired state and publish the provider.

- Activate one-click payment to keep the token saved for upcoming payments.

- Go to *Spaces* -> Settings -> Payment -> Payment Methods.
- Open the payment method on which token should be stored.

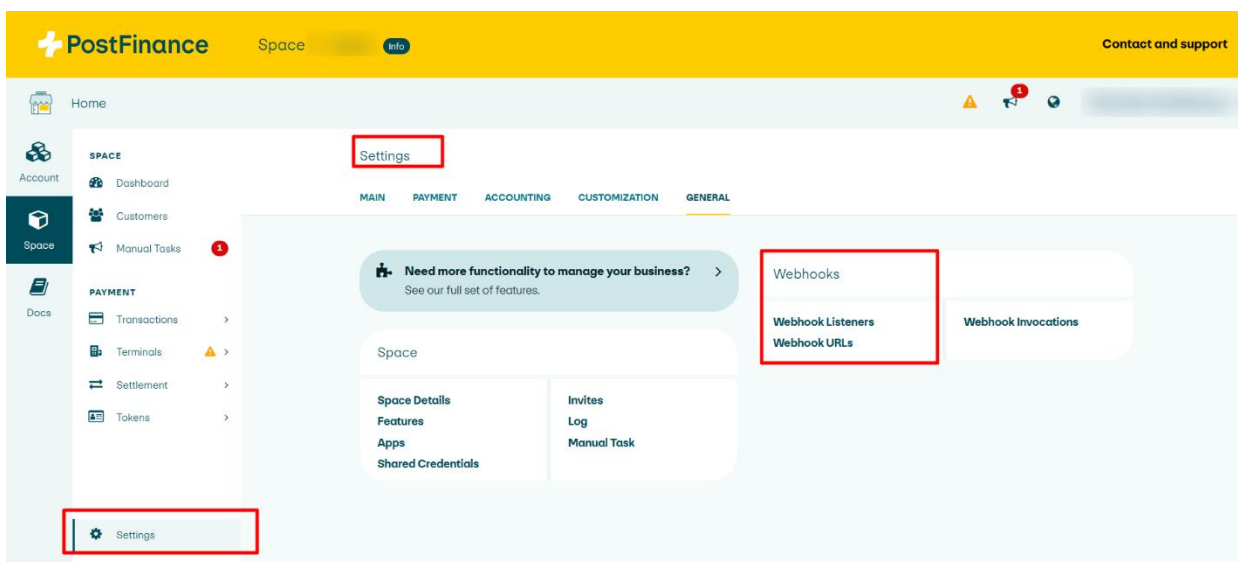
- Choose the appropriate option as required.

PostFinance Webhook Configuration

To ensure that transaction status updates are correctly delivered to Odoo, our payment provider module uses a dedicated webhook listener. This listener receives asynchronous notifications directly from PostFinance whenever a transaction changes its state (e.g., *Authorized, Completed, Failed*, etc.).

Follow the steps below to configure the Webhook URL and Webhook Listener in the PostFinance Back Office.

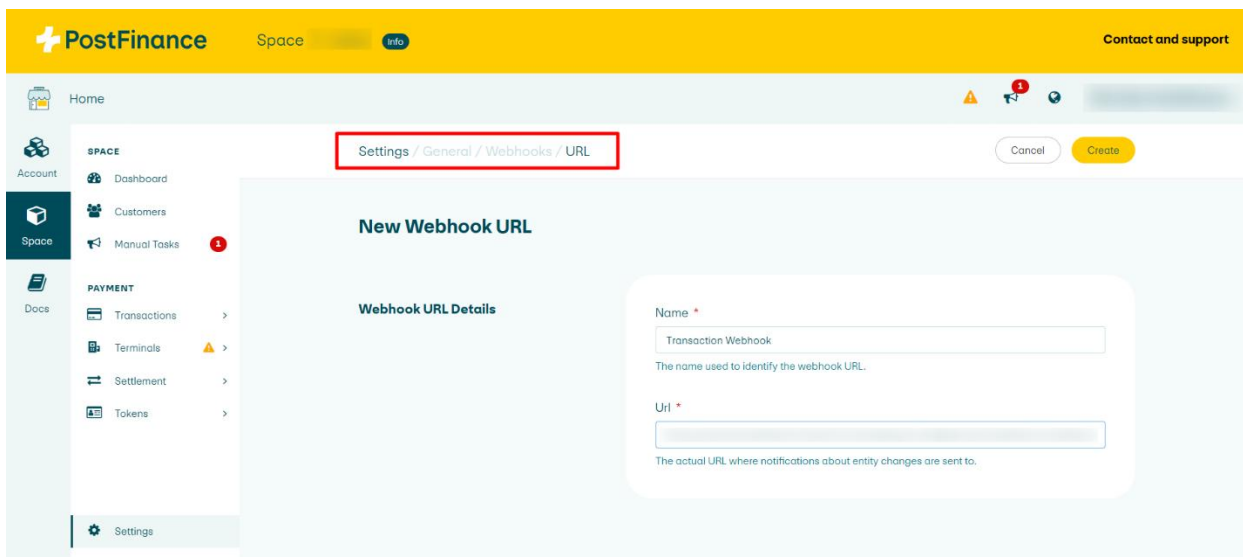
- Navigate to Settings page of the associated Space:
 - *Space* → *Settings* → *General* → *Webhooks*
 - Here you will see the webhook sections such as **Webhook URLs**, **Webhook Listeners** and **Webhook Invocations**.
 - These sections allow you to create listeners and check past webhook deliveries.



Screenshot 8: PostFinance Webhook Settings Page

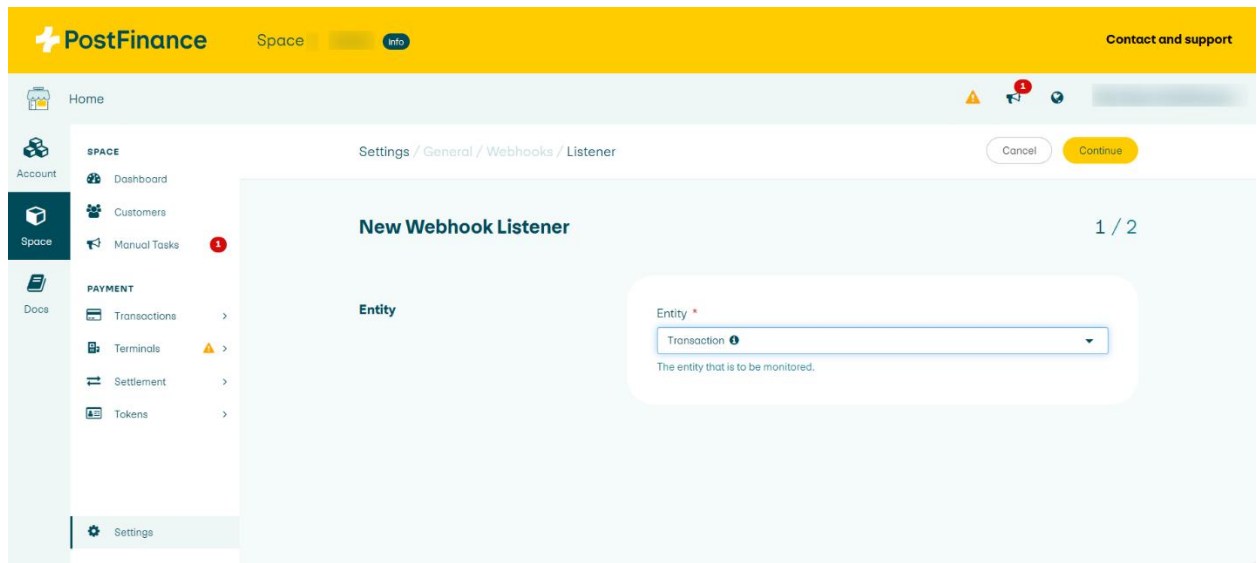
- Create a Webhook URL
 - *Space* → *Settings* → *General* → *Webhooks* → *Webhook URLs*
 - Click **Create** to add a new Webhook URL.
 - Provide a Webhook URL name. E.g.: Transaction Webhook.

- In the URL column fill your domain address followed by our webhook path
“/payment/postfinance/webhook”
- E.g.: *https://yourdomain.com/payment/postfinance/webhook*



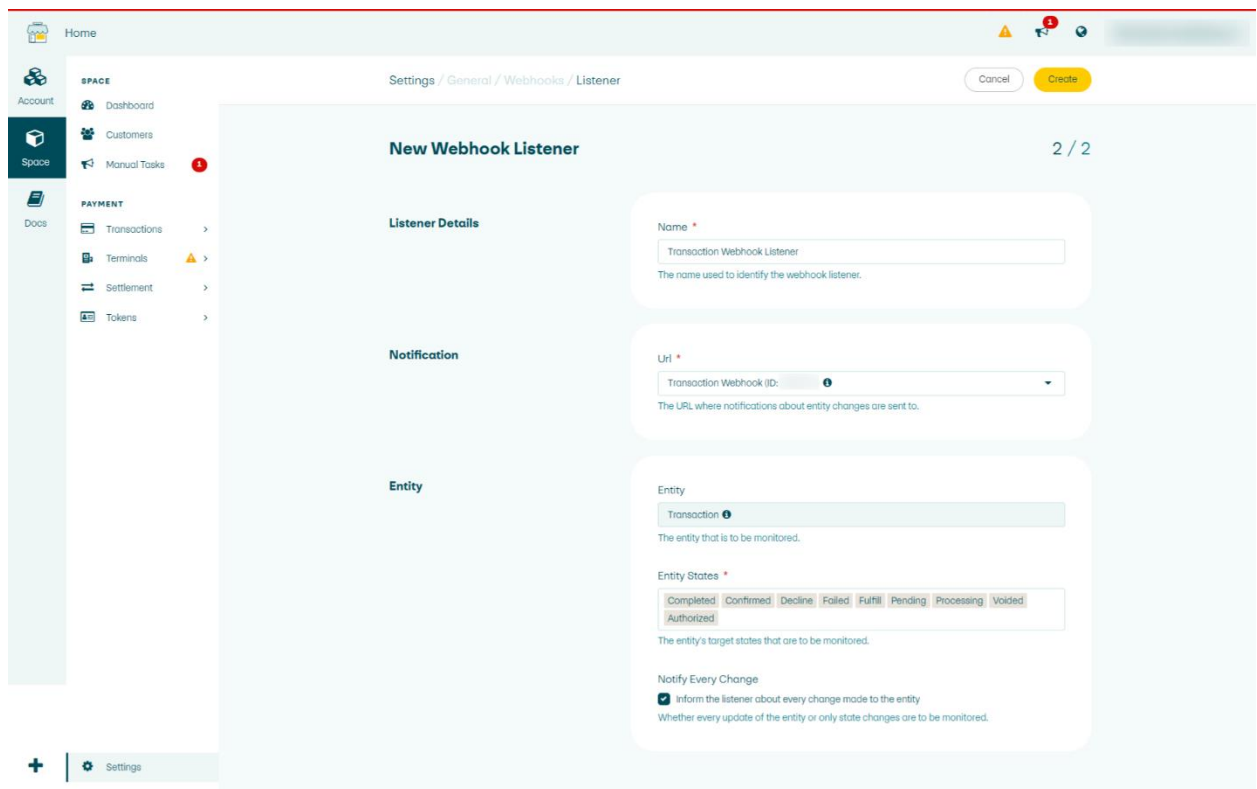
Screenshot 9: Creating a Webhook URL

- Navigate back to Webhook Settings page
 - *Space → Settings → General → Webhooks*
- Create a new Webhook Listener
 - *Space → Settings → General → Webhooks → Webhook Listeners*
 - Click **Create webhook listener** to add a new Webhook URL.
- On page 1 select the Entity: Transaction from the dropdown list and click on **Continue**.

- On page 2 off 2, complete the listener configuration.
 - **Name:** Add a name for the Webhook Listener. E.g.: Transaction Webhook Listener.
 - **URL:** Choose the webhook URL that was created earlier.
 - **Entity:** Automatically set to **Transaction**.
 - **Entity States:** Choose all the states.
- Click **Create** to save the webhook listener.

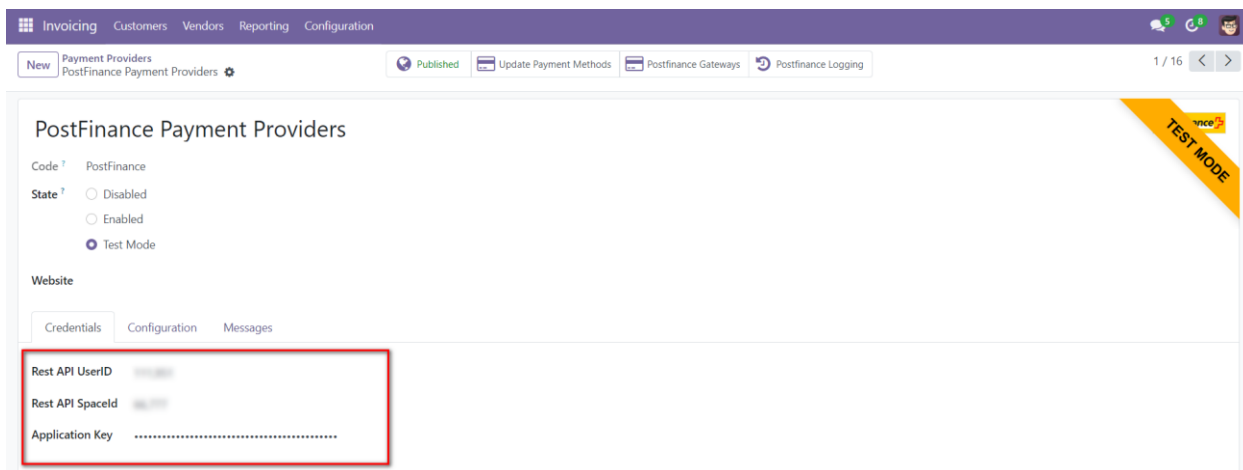

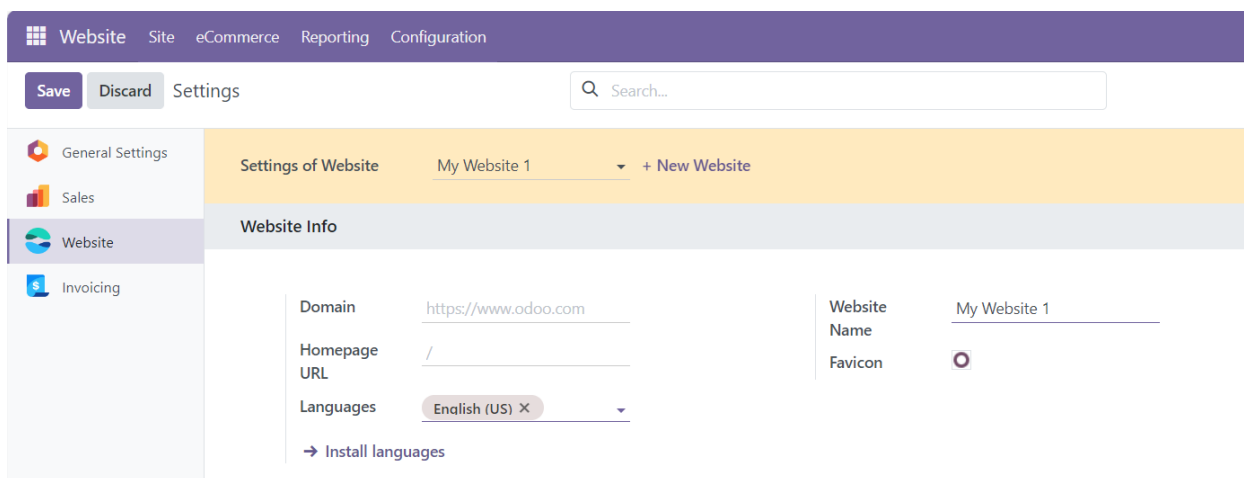

Screenshot 12: PostFinance configuration in Odoo backend

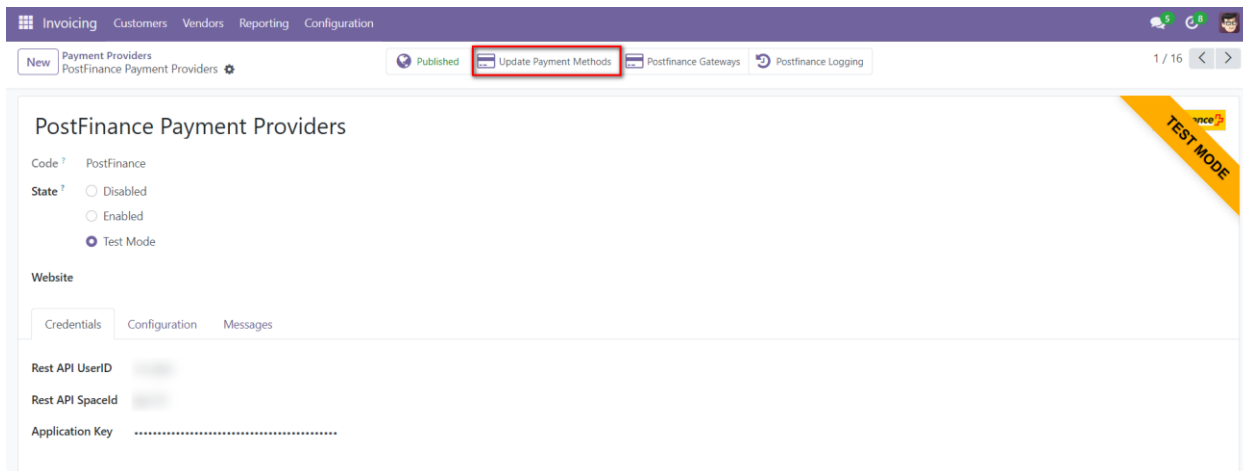
Note: The PostFinance Pay method only supports CHF and EUR as transaction currencies. Any payments attempted with other currencies will not be processed.

- Navigate to *Website > Configuration > Settings* to create and configure websites as per the requirement.

- Select the appropriate Website in the Website column to restrict the Payment provider to that specific website. Leaving this column blank will make this provider available in all the websites.

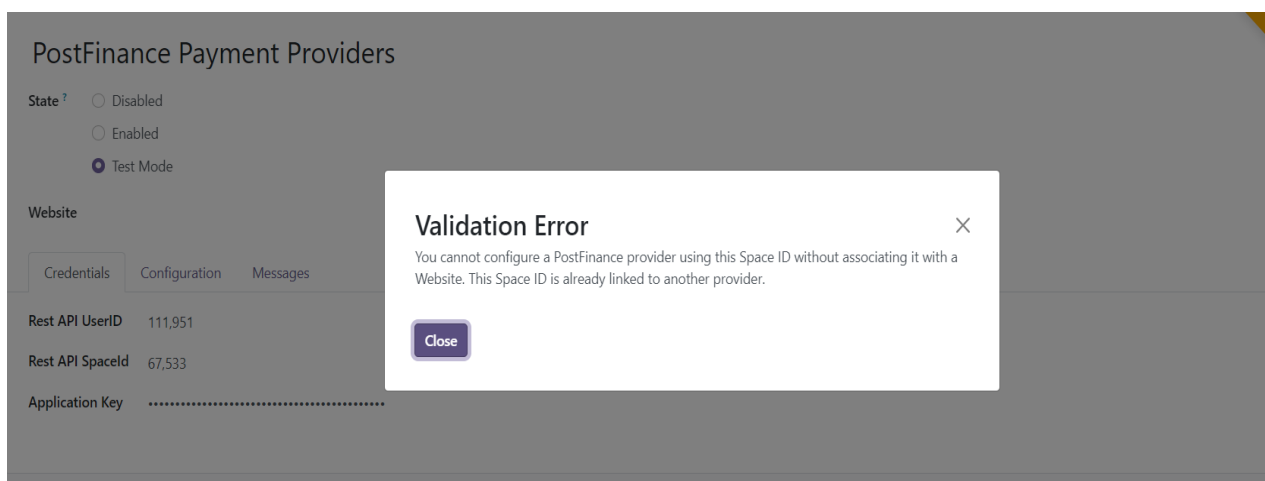
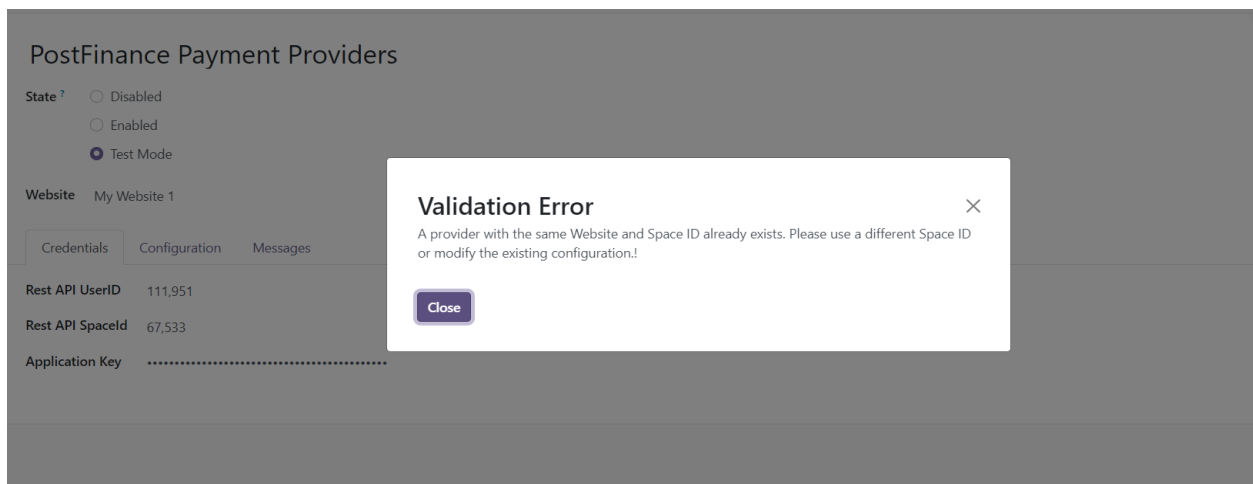


Screenshot 14: PostFinance Update Payment Methods

- Click on Update Payment Methods smart button to sync payment methods data from PostFinance back-office.
- The application will raise a warning if the user attempts to configure a provider that meets any of the following conditions:
 - **Condition 1: Duplicate Website and Space ID Combination**
If a provider with the same combination of Website and Space ID is already configured, the system will raise a warning. This prevents duplication and ensures consistency across payment configurations.
 - **Condition 2: Space ID Already Linked to Another Provider Without a Website**
A warning will be raised if the user attempts to configure a provider using a *Space ID* that is already linked to another provider without an associated website. This is critical because a provider configured without a website is accessible across all websites, making the new configuration redundant, as the existing provider already covers all potential payment scenarios.

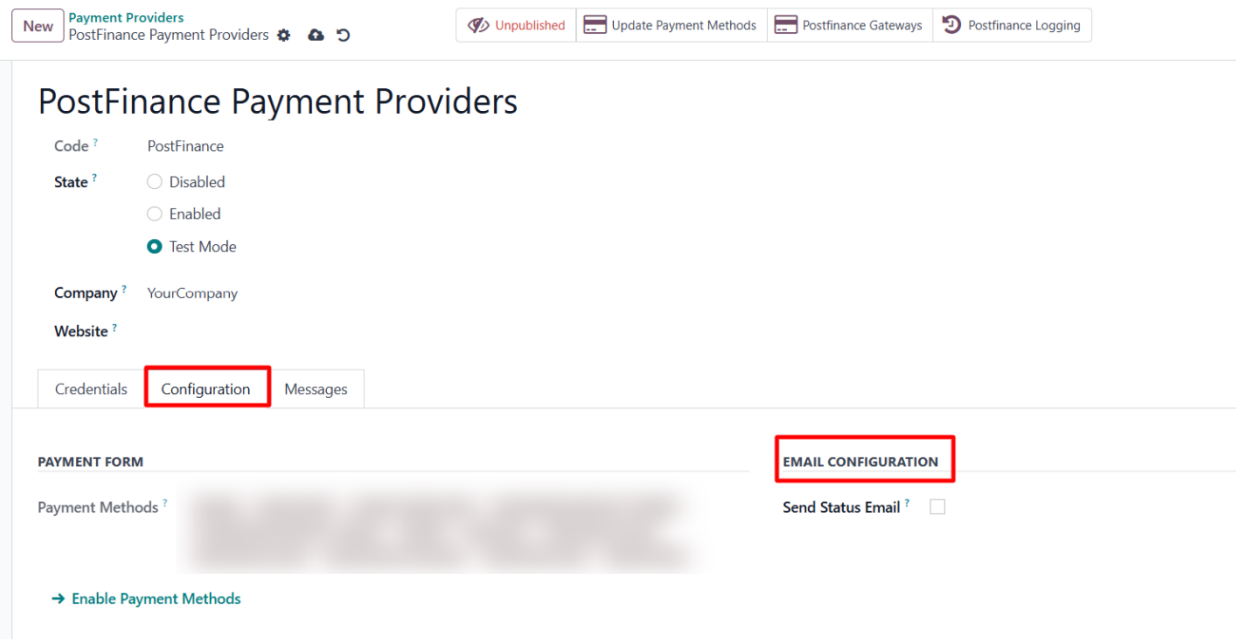
○ Condition 3: Configuring a Provider Using a Space ID Without Linking to a Website

If the user configures a provider using a *Space ID* but does not associate it with a website, the system will issue a warning. This is because such a configuration would override all other providers using the same *Space ID*. To resolve this, the user must either disable the other configurations using the same *Space ID* or remove any existing website links from those configurations.



Screenshot 15: Validations

The **Email Configuration** section in the Configuration tab of PostFinance Payment Provider allows administrators to control which transaction-related emails are automatically sent to customers during the payment lifecycle.

By enabling or disabling these options, the administrator can decide when the system should send notification emails related to payment status updates.

- **Available Configuration Options**

- **Send Status Email**

When enabled, the system will send an email notification to the customer whenever the payment status is updated. Disabling this will disable all the transaction related emails.

- **Send Pending Email**

If this option is enabled, an email will be sent to the customer when the payment transaction is marked as **Pending**.

- **Send Cancel Email**

When enabled, customers will receive an email notification if the payment transaction is **Canceled**.

- **Send Confirmation Email**

This option triggers a confirmation email to the customer when the payment is **successfully completed**.

- **How It Works**

- If **Send Status Email** is enabled, the additional email options become available.
- The administrator can select which specific status emails should be sent.
- When the corresponding payment event occurs, Odoo automatically sends the configured email notification to the customer.

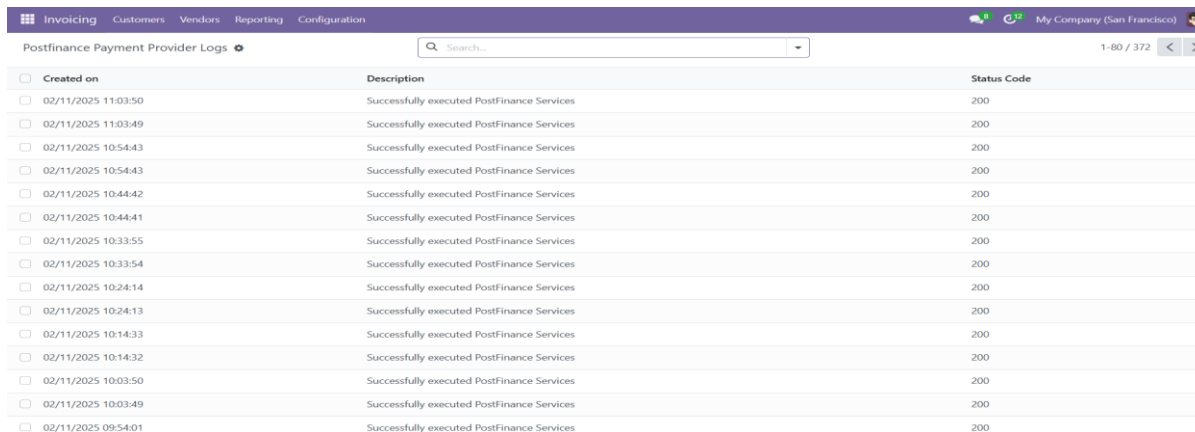

4. Brief description

For the smooth functioning of this plugin, a few backend configurations need to be set up. The initial step involves configuring the **PostFinance Acquirer**, where the **User ID**, **Space ID**, and **Application Key** from your PostFinance Flex account must be provided. Once this configuration is completed, activate the provider, and users can proceed with shopping. The PostFinance Flex payment methods will then appear on the shop's payment page. Customers can select their preferred **PostFinance payment method**, pay via the payment page or popup window, and then return to the Odoo Webshop.

Step-by-Step Instructions

Prerequisites: Before integrating the PostFinance payment acquirer plugin, ensure that you have a PostFinance account. You can create one at <https://checkout.postfinance.ch/> which facilitates easy verification and transaction processing.

Step 1: Set Up PostFinance Account and Configure Payment Acquirer.

- Enter your **User ID**, **Space ID**, and **Application Key** from your PostFinance Flex account.

Step 2: Activate/Publish/Enable the PostFinance Payment Provider.

Step 3: Navigate to the e-commerce website -> Add products to the cart -> Proceed to checkout.

Step 4: Select the **PostFinance Flex** payment method and click **Pay Now**.

Step 5: Complete the transaction by entering the necessary details on the payment page or in the popup window.

Step 6: Once the payment is successful, the order will be placed.

5. Technical Requirements / Compatible With:

- Compatible with Odoo community version 17.0

6. Limitations

- **Cryptocurrency Payment Unavailable:** Please be aware that cryptocurrency payments powered by PostFinance are currently not supported. This limitation is due to PostFinance and is outside of our control. We recommend using alternative supported payment methods to complete your transaction.
